

Men's and Women's Basketball Referee Camp

The Kentucky Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Supervisors will hold an official's basketball referee training and development camp in Lexington, KY in conjunction with the AAU High School State Championship Tournament. This camp will be for the development of officials on the high school as well as the collegiate level. It will be all 3 person officiating training.

Whether you desire to get into the Collegiate ranks as an official or just want to work on your game for the High School level, this camp is for you. The staff includes assigning secretaries from within the state of Kentucky, College Supervisors, and the KHSAA Supervisor of officials.

You will find a staff of knowledgeable professionals who are willing to help you improve your game. You will not find another camp with the caliber of clinicians at this low cost.

The top rated officials in the camp will be asked to work the Semi Finals and Finals of the Tournament on Sunday, June 21.

The games will all be played at the Kentucky Basketball Academy in Lexington, KY. The entire facility is air conditioned, and all courts are actual size and regulation. There are no out of bounds lines drawn on the court to try making two courts out of one as you have at some camps. The dates of the camp are starting the morning of June 18 and completing on Sunday evening, June 21.

Campers will be divided in two groups dependent upon your experience of 3-person

officiating. Those with no 3-person experience will be placed in a group which will involve detailed training starting at 6:30PM on June 17. Note: **this is a day before the start of camp.**

The \$250.00 camp cost covers all instructions and a camp "T" shirt. Meals and rooms are not provided in the cost of the camp. However rooms have been set aside at the Crown Plaza Campbell House Hotel at a special rate of \$85.04 per day. A hospitality room will be provided each evening at the hotel. Reservations for the hotel should be made by each camper through the hotel. They will accept up to 4 persons per room. The rate is good until May 31. Call the hotel at 1-859 255-4281 and tell them you are with the KIAC Clinic.

Check in for campers will be at the Crown Plaza Hotel Campbell House from 7:30AM to 9:00AM on Thursday, June 18. This will be followed by a camp meeting at 9:30AM. Games will start on Thursday, June 18 at 12:00pm and will complete on Sunday afternoon, June 21.
