

The 2011 Mid-Atlantic Basketball Officiating School will be conducted October 7th – October 8th on the campus of West Chester University. The camp will be held in conjunction with the Mid-Atlantic Team Basketball Camp. All basketball officials, both male and female, who are interested in becoming better officials, are invited to attend. Enrollment will be limited to the first 60 officials to submit their paid deposit.

PURPOSE

Mid-Atlantic Basketball Officiating School is designed to provide a more efficient system for the advancement of aspiring basketball officials. This camp provides a great opportunity for all officials to develop their skills and been seen by local assignors and hopefully improve their officiating schedule with better games.. Several of our past campers have been hired at the College Level. The camp is designed to help officials reach their goals.

FORMAT

The weekend format should allow you to minimize any absence from work. Camp will begin at 4:30 p.m. on Friday with check-in and classroom sessions beginning at 5:30pm. The school will end Saturday at 9 p.m.

BEGINNING OFFICIALS

Give you an opportunity to improve mechanics and gain experience from assignors and veteran officials. This school will give you the opportunity to learn the proper mechanics and positioning on the floor.

VETERAN OFFICIAL

For those looking to make advancements in officiating, this camp may be what you are seeking. Some of our prior campers have advanced to the varsity high school level, as well as the junior college and collegiate levels.

COST

The cost of the camp will be \$120.

GAMES

All games will be played indoors using National Federation rules. Outstanding area teams will compete in closely contested games. A number of games will be videotaped to enable camper's detailed review of their game.

CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION

Classroom instruction will be used to discuss game situations along with rules interpretations and how to break down video tape.

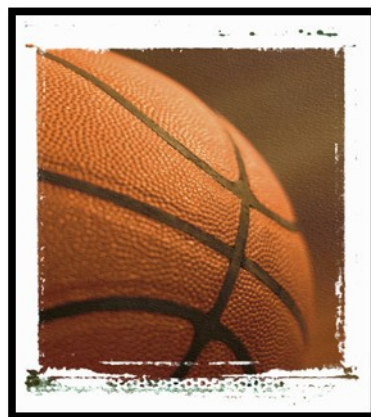
WAIVER
