WHEN—Week 1 June 16-June 19 (Linden) Week 2 June 30-July 3 (Elizabeth) from 5-9 PM

FORMAT—The camp will emphasize on-court officiating and proper mechanics for 2 & 3 person (state tournament requirement) officiating. Games being played as part of the highly competitive Linden HS Tiger Team Camp will provide competitive situations that will allow for strengths and weaknesses to be properly evaluated. Extensive feedback will be provided to each camper at the conclusion of the camp week. In the past, campers have been able to expand their schedules and have gone on to work quality varsity level, county and state tournament assignments.
