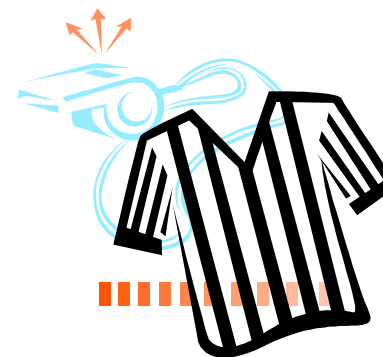

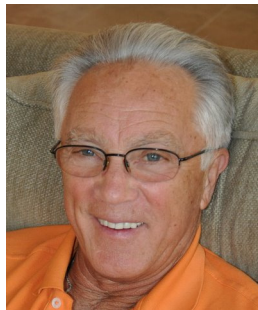

## CAMP DIRECTOR



Dan Hooper officiated for 26 years at various levels of collegiate and high school basketball. He is currently the Coordinator of Officials for the Sacramento Association of Collegiate Officials (SACO) and Supervisor of Officials for the Pacific West Conference. He assigns officials to D-II, D-III, NAIA and Junior Colleges in California. Dan is also the assigner for the men's and women's games in the California Community College State Tournament. In addition to his assigning duties, Dan sponsors several referee instructional camps at CSU-Chico and conducts four NCAA sanctioned Jamborees for training and instructing officials annually.

Dan has assembled a knowledgeable, highly respected and experienced camp staff that includes a Final Four official, several D-1 officials currently working games in the Pacific-10, West Coast, Big Sky and Big West Conferences; a D League official; and the past Supervisor of Officials of the Pacific-10 who is currently an observer for the West Coast Conference.

## CAMP STAFF

The camp staff is comprised of experienced officials who will analyze your officiating skills. You will be taught to understand rules, game control, preventive officiating, mechanics, individual problem solving and much more. An evaluator will critique your video floor work after each game.

**Charles Range** has approximately 36 years experience refereeing at the Division I level. He has worked in the PAC-10, WAC, Big-12, Big Sky, Big West, WCC, ACC and Conference USA conferences and has worked in the NCAA Tournament 26 consecutive years with 3 Final Four appearances. Charles currently works as an observer for the Big Sky, Pac-10, West Coast, Pac West and SACO Conferences.

**Alan Pierce** has 18 years of experience at the high school, junior college, NAIA, D2 and DI levels. Currently Alan officiates in the PacWest, SACO, and BRONC conferences, and has 5 years experience in the West Coast Conference. Alan brings over 10 years of instructor experience to our camp.



**Shelley Russi** has over 17 years of officiating experience including 15 seasons as a DI referee. Her current affiliations include Pac-10, Mountain West, Big Sky, West Coast, and Big West Conferences. Shelley has been invited to officiate at several conference tournaments and was selected as an alternate in 2010 for the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Cobán Lopez** has 14 years of experience. He is currently officiating at the DI/II level in the West Coast, Big West, Pac West and SACO Conferences. Cobán has attended numerous officiating camps as both a participant and an instructor.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the camp is to develop/train current and potential officials in the six areas that are foundational to success in officiating in the Pac West Conference: Those 6 areas include:

1. Knowledge of NCAA rules (Men & Women)
2. Play Calling
3. Court Presence
4. Fitness
5. On and Off Court Responsibilities
6. Personal Qualities – Character and Integrity

This camp is for any official, regardless of level of experience, who wants to improve and sharpen his or her officiating skills. You will learn game control, officiating both ends of the court, preventive officiating, individual problem-solving, 3-person mechanics and professional approach to officiating.

This camp will be a three-day training program designed to provide you with intense classroom instruction and on court critique of your officiating

Pac West Conference Supervisor of Officials (Men & Women) will be directing the camp, evaluating and recruiting officials to officiate in the 2011-2012 Pac West Conference.
