REGISTRATION AND CANCELLATION POLICY

The camp fee is \$250.00 which is due with the application. Deadline to apply is June 1, 2011.

The camp is limited to the first 60 officials who submit their application accompanied with camp fee. Completed applications will be established by postmark date. Applicants who are not among the first 60 will be placed on a waiting list and have their registration fee returned if an opening does not become available.

If for some reason you need to cancel, a 50% refund will be issued until Friday May 22, 2011. Because of fixed cost, no refunds can be made after that date. Each camper will receive a camp memento.

CAMP UNIFORMS

Each official should bring several basketball official's shirts (no logos), black pants or shorts, black shoes and other necessary equipment.

ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments will utilize the 3-person system. Each official will work all three positions. Each official will be critiqued and evaluated by a clinician.
